An extraordinary event in the autumn months

Level of difficulty: Easy summer excursion, hike without steep sections on wide hiking trails.

Sport or light trekking shoes are sufficient.

Equipment: Sports or trekking shoes, rain protection, suitable clothing, backpack with

drinks and snacks, binoculars.

Costs: €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by

their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!

Dogs: The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration

or other participants and local wildlife.

Meeting point: September 25, 2025, 6:00 PM, and October 2, 2025, 5:30 PM at the exhibition

'Im Facettenreich' in Rauris. Coordinates: N 47.19597, E 12.97580.

How to reach us: Rauris is easily accessible from the region – by car via Taxenbach or by bus

(line 640) from the Taxenbach-Rauris train station.

The exhibition 'Im Facettenreich' is centrally located in the village

(Dorfstraße 27, 5661 Rauris), just a few minutes' walk from the bus stop.

Duration: Approximately 2 hours.

Route: In carpool groups, short walking distance on foot.

Refreshment stops: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.

Booking: Registration possible until 12:00 noon on the day of the tour.
