

Into the Valley of Emeralds

Bramberg Treasure Chamber

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Monday (from July 7, 2025, to September 1, 2025) at 9:00 AM at the Habachtal parking lot (info hut). Coordinates: N 47.24823 / E 12.31816.
- How to reach us:** Take the bus (line 670) to the "Weyer - Weyerhof" stop, then walk for 20 minutes. Alternatively, drive to the Habachtal parking lot.
- Duration:** Approximately 4 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 2.5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 6 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 500 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible until two hours before the beginning of the tour at www.npht.at/emeralds

Description: The tour begins at the info hut at the Habachtal parking lot. After just a few meters, the group leaves the road and enters the "Smaragdweg" (Emerald Trail). Along the way, the ranger shares insights about the unique features of the glacial valley and its green, shimmering treasure: valuable emeralds. Participants also learn how to search for stones and where searching is permitted. Nature observations are not neglected either—with a bit of luck, one might spot a golden eagle or marmots. The tour ends at the Almgasthof Alpenrose, where visitors can take a break before returning to the starting point, either with the ranger or via the "Emerald Taxi."
