



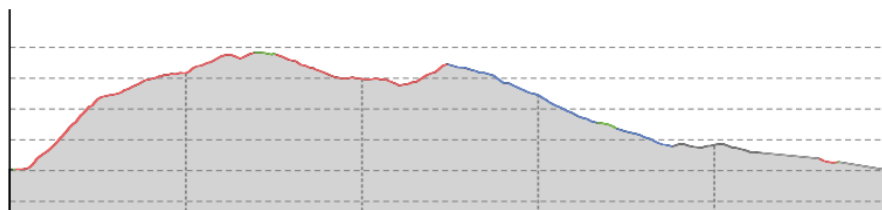
Rauriser Urwald - Rauris Primeval Forest

Forest in its original state

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Monday (from 07.07.2025 to 01.09.2025) at 09:00 AM at the Lenzanger parking lot (info hut). Coordinates: N 47.08198 / E 12.98500.
- How to reach us:** By bus (Line 640) to the "Kolm Saigurn – Parkplatz Lenzanger" bus stop or by car to the Lenzanger parking lot (toll and parking fees apply).
- Duration:** Approximately 4 hours.
Pure walking time: Approximately 2.5 hours.
Route: Approximately 5 kilometers.
Ascent: Approximately 250 meters in altitude.
Refreshment stops: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible up to two hours before the tour starts at www.npht.at/primeval-forest

Description: The tour begins at the info hut at the Lenzanger parking lot (meeting point). From there, the hike leads past dark moor ponds, giant trees, and tall Swiss stone pines. Romantic clearings alongside ancient spruce and larch stands make the landscape appear like a green jungle. Visitors will learn more about the unique features of this natural gem in the Rauris Valley from the ranger. After leaving the primeval forest, the hike passes the Naturfreundehaus Kolm Saigurn and follows the access road back to the starting point.
