



Krimml Waterfalls



The highest waterfalls in Austria

Level of difficulty: Moderate summer excursion on well-maintained paths or easy hiking trails

leading to a destination above the valley floor; hiking or mountain shoes with

a treaded sole are required.

Equipment: Backpack, sun protection, ankle-high hiking boots, drink and snack, change of

clothes, hat and gloves, possibly trekking poles.

Costs: €22 for adults. Children and teenagers (ages 10–16) accompanied by their

parents participate for free.

Free with a Guest Card or National Park Summer Card!

Dogs: The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration

for other participants and local wildlife.

Meeting point: Every Thursday (July 10, 2025 – September 4, 2025) at 09:00 AM at the

How to reach us: By bus (line 670) - get off at "Krimml Ortsmitte" or by car to the "Krimmler

Wasserfälle" parking lots.

Duration: Approximately 5 hours (approx. 3.5 hours of guided tour) **Pure walking time:** Approximately 3,5 hours (approx. 2.0 hours of guided tour) **Route:** Approximately 9 kilometers. (approx. 4.5 km of guided tour)

Ascent: Approximately 450 meters in altitude. **Refreshment stops**: Refreshment possible after the tour.

Description: Experience Austria's highest waterfalls on a guided ranger tour! Our tour begins at the Krimml Tourism Association, where you will be welcomed by an experienced ranger. The hike follows the historic ascent on the left side of the waterfalls. As you climb, you will enjoy breathtaking views and learn fascinating facts about the historic trade route, as well as the region's flora and fauna. After conquering all waterfall tiers and a total drop of 385 meters, you will reach the entrance to the Krimml Achental. Here, the guided tour ends, and you can choose to either continue your hike further into the Krimml Achental or return to the starting point via the other side of the waterfalls. This route offers additional spectacular views and great photo opportunities.
