



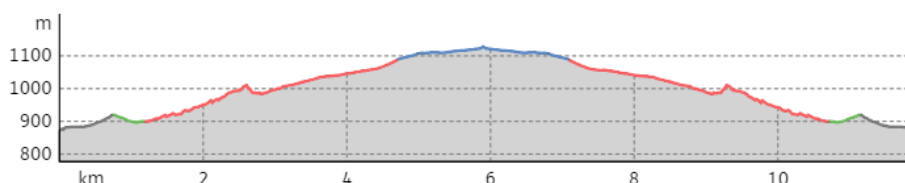
## Bachlehrweg Hollersbach

### Mosses, ferns, and lichens

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Thursday (from July 10, 2025, to September 4, 2025) at 09:00 at the Gasthof Seestube in Hollersbach. Coordinates: N 47.26616 / E 12.41354.
- How to reach us:** Follow the B165 to the Hollersbach exit and continue to the town center, following signs for Seestube/Hollersbachtal. Use the regional bus line to the Hollersbach Ortsmitte stop. From there, it is approximately a 15-minute walk to the Gasthof Seestube.
- Duration:** Approximately 5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 3.5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 12 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 270 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Refreshments available at the Senningeralm
- Booking:** Registration possible up to two hours before the tour starts at [www.npht.at/hollersbach-en](http://www.npht.at/hollersbach-en)

**Description:** Our tour starts at the Gasthof Seestube in Hollersbach. From here, we follow the rushing Hollersbach stream along the beautiful Stream Educational Trail until we reach the Senningeralm. The path takes us through a pristine gray alder grove, where mosses, ferns, and the impressive butterbur with its large leaves thrive. With a bit of luck, we might spot white-throated dippers, the only diving songbirds, and in the following spruce forest, we will discover brightly colored lichens. Our ranger will inform you about the unique flora and fauna in the area. Before reaching the Senningeralm, we pass historic stone walls built from cleared stones, and at the Senningeralm, the valley opens up into a vast alpine meadow landscape. The official tour ends here. It's time to either enjoy a break or begin the return journey on the alpine road.
