



Hike to Reedsee

Idyllic mountain lake surrounded by a mountain forest

- Level of difficulty:** Long, endurance excursion leading through steep terrain and accessible via trails.
- Equipment:** Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (12–16 years) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with guest card or National Park Summer Card!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration or other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Friday (from 11.07.2025 to 05.09.2025) at 08:15 AM at the Grüner Baum bus stop, coordinates: N 47.12759 / E 13.15978.
- How to reach us:** By bus (Line 555) to the "Grüner Baum" bus stop, alternatively by car to the Grüner Baum bus stop, coordinates: N 47.12759 / E 13.15978.
- Duration:** Approximately 6-7 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 5 hours
- Route:** Approximately 11 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 800 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possibility for refreshments after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration is possible up to two hours before the tour starts at www.npht.at/lake-reedsee

Description: The hike starts at the Grüner Baum bus stop. The well-developed path steadily ascends into the Kötschachtal. After approximately 3 kilometers, the hike branches off onto a trail towards Reedsee. After about 3 hours, the tour reaches its preliminary peak – Reedsee. This is a mountain lake, nestled idyllically in the mountain forest with the backdrop of surrounding peaks. After a leisurely break, the return journey follows the same route.
