

Off to the Wildalm

Located high between the Habachtal and Untersulzbach valleys

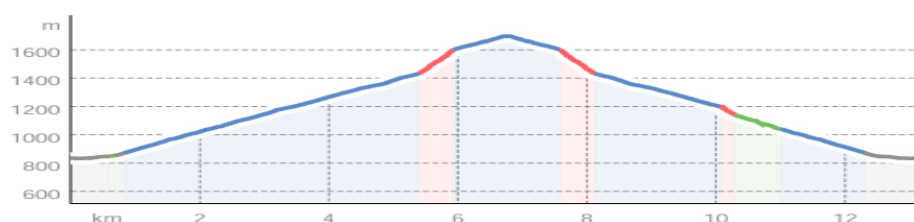
- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Monday (from July 13 to September 7, 2026) at 9:00 a.m. at the sports ground parking area in Neukirchen (train station).
Coordinates: N 47.251087 / E 12.281620.
- How to reach us:** By bus (line 670) to the "Neukirchen Ortsmitte" stop, followed by a 5-minute walk; alternatively, by car to the sports ground parking area.
- Duration:** Approximately 7,5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 6 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 13 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 850 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible until three hours before the beginning of the tour at npht.at/to-the-wildalm

Description: The tour begins at the Neukirchen sports ground, where the Salzach River is first crossed. Following the cycle path and then a forest road, the route steadily climbs the "shady side" of Neukirchen.

Along the way, the ranger shares interesting facts about the forest, its functions, threats, and what the valley originally looked like in its natural state. At around 1,700 meters, upon reaching the Wildalm, the landscape opens up again, offering views down into the Salzach Valley.

The alpine pasture has been managed by an association for the past few years – a new concept for a traditional alpine pasture.
