

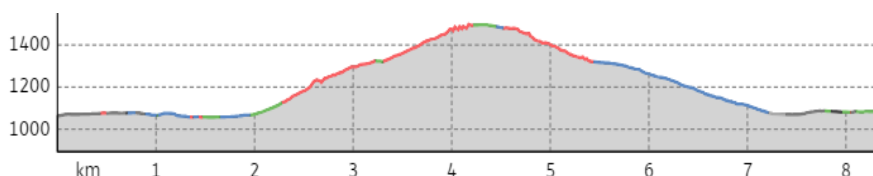
Krimml Waterfalls

The biggest waterfalls in Austria

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-maintained paths or easy hiking trails leading to a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Hiking or mountaineering boots with treaded soles, rain and sun protection, suitable clothing and a change of clothes, and a backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and teenagers (ages 10–16) accompanied by their parents participate for free. Free with a Guest Card or National Park Summer Card!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Tuesday (from July 14 to September 8, 2026) at 9:00 a.m. at the Krimml Tourist Office (coordinates: N 47.22207 / E 12.17545).
- How to reach us:** By bus (line 670) - get off at "Krimml Ortsmitte" or by car to the "Krimmler Wasserfälle" parking lots.
- Duration:** Approximately 5 hours
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 3,5 hours
- Route:** Approximately 9 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 450 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Refreshment possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible up to three hours before the tour starts at www.npht.at/waterfalls

Description: Experience Austria's highest waterfalls on a guided ranger tour! The tour begins at the Krimml Tourist Office, where you will be welcomed by an experienced ranger. During the ascent, you can enjoy breathtaking views and learn interesting facts about the historic trade route as well as the local flora and fauna. After overcoming all waterfall stages with a total drop height of 385 meters, you will reach the entrance to the Krimml Achental valley. From here, you can decide whether to continue hiking a bit further into the valley or return to the starting point with the ranger. The return route offers additional spectacular views and plenty of photo opportunities.
