

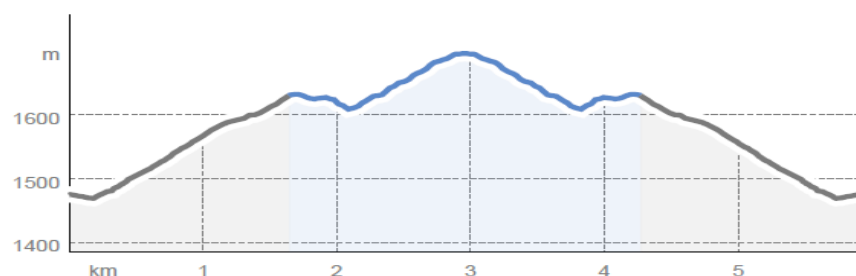
Along the Wurfbach stream

To the Wurfalm and the panorama of the surrounding mountain landscape

- Level of difficulty:** A light summer excursion on wide hiking trails
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Tuesday (14 July 2026–8 September 2026) at 09:30 a.m. at the valley station of the Weißsee Glacier World.
(coordinates: 47.169484 N, 12.624672 E)
- How to reach us:** Take the bus (line 672) to the stop 'Enzingerboden Weißsee cable car valley station' or drive by car to the parking area.
- Duration:** Approximately 4 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 2,5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 6 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 250 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible until three hours before the beginning of the tour at npht.at/river-wurfbach

Description: Experience the side valley of the Stubach Valley as part of a guided ranger tour! Our tour begins at the valley station of the Weißsee Glacier cable car and leads us—gently ascending—deeper into the Wurfbach Valley. A popular ski touring destination in winter, it becomes a scenic summer hike offering beautiful views of the unique mountain landscape. Along the way, the ranger shares interesting facts about the flora and fauna, explains why a trip into the high alpine region is practically a 'journey to the Arctic', and raises awareness for respectful and mindful behavior in nature. The return route follows the same path.
