



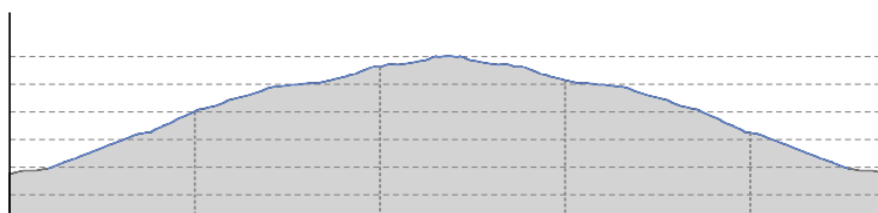
Kings of the Skies

Into the valley of vultures

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!.
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Wednesday (from July 15 to September 9, 2026) at 8:45 a.m. at the information hut in Krumltal. Coordinates: N 47.12739 / E 12.98159.
- How to reach us:** By bus (Line 640) to the stop "Bucheiben Lechnerhäusl" – then a 5-minute walk; alternatively, by car to the Krumltal parking lot.
- Duration:** Approximately 6 hours
Pure walking time: Approximately 4 hours.
Route: Approximately 10 kilometers.
Ascent: Approximately 450 meters in altitude.
Refreshment stops: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible up to three hours before the tour starts at www.npht.at/kings-of-skies

Description: The hike follows the Krumlbach stream, leading deeper into the Krumltal valley. The ranger shares fascinating insights about the great birds of prey. During short stops, spotting scopes are set up to scan the sky for birds. With a bit of luck, you may spot bearded vultures, griffon vultures, cinereous vultures, golden eagles, chamois, and ibex. The return journey follows the same route.
