

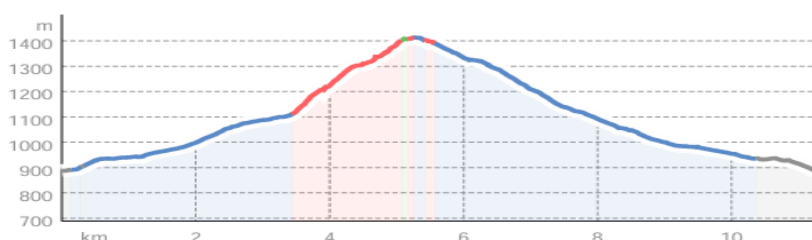
Kampriesen Round

Discover the entrance to the Obersulzbach Valley

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Wednesday (from July 15, 2026 to September 9, 2026) at 9:00 a.m. at the Siggen information hut (coordinates: N 47.231519 / E 12.246657).
- How to reach us:** By car to the Siggen parking lot (subject to a fee)
- Duration:** Approximately 6,5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 4,5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 11 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 500 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible until three hours before the beginning of the tour at npht.at/kampriesen-en

Description: The tour begins at the newly built information hut in the Sulzau district of Neukirchen. Passing the Blausee, the trail follows the stream, steadily ascending into the valley. Due to the stream's strong dynamics, deep cuttings and ongoing natural processes can be observed throughout. Using this 'illustrative material,' the shaping power of water is explored, while also highlighting the animals and plants that depend on this constantly changing habitat. At the level of the Kampriesenalm, the group will decide together whether to return along the same path or continue along the easily walkable track.
