

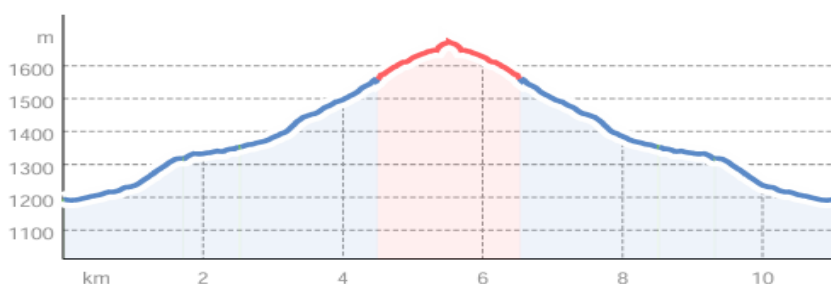
Explore the Anlauf Valley

Old paths rediscovered..

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Wednesday (from July 15, 2026 to September 9, 2026) at 9:30 a.m. at the Anlaufthal parking lot in Bad Gastein.
(coordinates: N 47.07607, E 13.137304).
- How to reach us:** By bus to the 'Böckstein Abz. Anlaufthal' stop or by train to Böckstein station, then on foot to the meeting point. By car to the parking lot.
(coordinates: N 47.07622, E 13.13723).
- Duration:** Approximately 5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 3 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 12 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 500 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Refreshments are available after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible up to three hours before the tour starts at npht.at/anlauf-valley

Description: Starting from the parking lot, the hike leads into the narrow and impressive Anlauf Valley. Along the way, the ranger will bring the unique flora and fauna of the Hohe Tauern National Park to life and share interesting stories about the region. The tour follows the scenic path along the Anlaufbach stream. Enjoy the fresh mountain air and untouched nature! The destination is the idyllic Radeckalm, where a short break will be taken to enjoy the surrounding mountain scenery. It is recommended to bring your own provisions, as there are no refreshments or service available at the hut. After the break, the return route follows.
