

Into the Weichselbach Valley

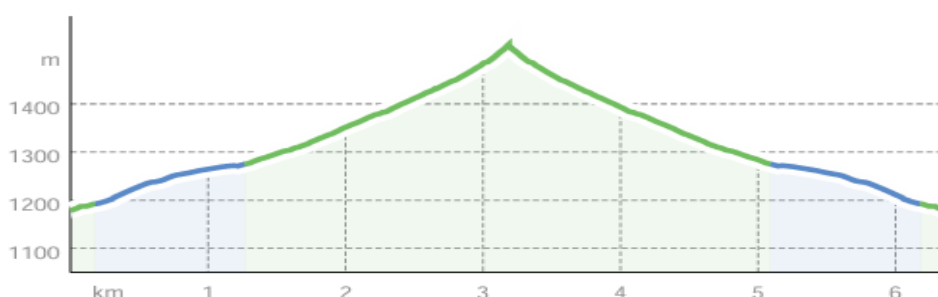
Explore Bad Fusch in summer.

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Thursday (from July 16 to September 10, 2026) at 9:00 a.m. at the Bad Fusch parking lot (coordinates: 47.20053, 12.85515)
- How to reach us:** By car to the Bad Fusch parking lot; no public transport access available.
- Duration:** Approximately 5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 2.5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 6,5 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 350 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Available after the tour
- Booking:** Registration possible up to three hours before the tour starts at npht.at/weichselbach-en

Description: The guided ranger tour in the Hohe Tauern National Park starts in Bad Fusch and follows the rushing Weichselbach stream into the valley. Over a route with an elevation gain of about 350 metres, the ranger shares interesting facts about alpine flora, wildlife, and the history of the former spa town with its healing springs.

The varied landscape of forests, alpine meadows, and mountain streams repeatedly offers beautiful views of the surrounding mountains. After a break in the upper part of the valley, the tour returns to Bad Fusch along the same route.
