

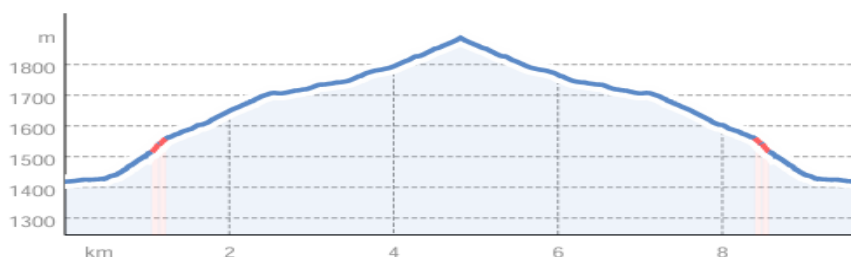
Into the Wildgerlos Valley

Over the roaring gorge to the Salzböden

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor;
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** Dogs are not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Friday (from July 17 to September 11, 2026) at 9:00 a.m. at the Alpengasthaus Finkau (coordinates: N 47.203840 / E 12.105833)
- How to reach us:** From Krimml, follow the signs along the Gerlos Alpine Road (toll road), or from Wald im Pinzgau follow the signs towards Königsleiten. Passing the reservoir, a road leads directly to the parking area at Gasthof Finkau (parking fee required).
- Duration:** Approximately 6,5 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 4 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 10 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 450 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Possible after the tour.
- Booking:** Registration possible until three hours before the beginning of the tour at npht.at/wildgerlos-valley

Description: From Gasthof Finkau, the hike begins along a well-maintained trail leading to the Leitenkammer Gorge. Viewing platforms provide impressive insights into the gorge. Along the stream, there is a chance to observe dippers as well as grey wagtails and white-throated dippers. From Trisslalm (1,584 m), the path continues deeper into the valley until the moraine from 1850 becomes clearly visible. During the tour, the shaping power of water and glaciers, as well as the typical high-mountain vegetation, are explained. The return route follows the same path.
