

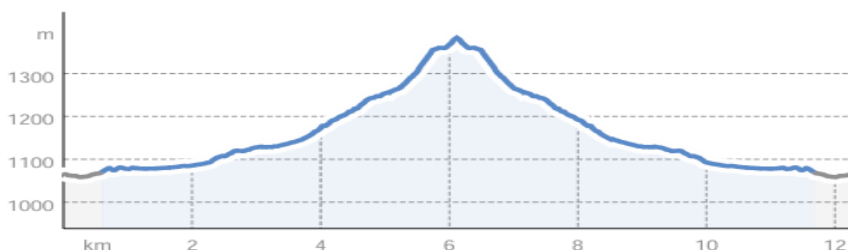
To Prossau in the Kötschach Valley.

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Every Friday (from July 17, 2026 to September 11, 2026) at 9:45 a.m. at the 'Grüner Baum' stop (coordinates: N 47.12759 / E 13.15978).
- How to reach us:** By bus (lines 550/555) to the 'Grüner Baum' stop, or alternatively by car to the parking area located there as well.
- Duration:** Approximately 6 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 4 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 12 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 350 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** available
- Booking:** Registration possible up to three hours before the tour starts at npht.at/koetschach-valley

Description: The tour starts at the former Hotel "Grüner Baum" and leads along a wide track into the valley, passing the impressive "Himmelwand." Along the way, the ranger shares insights into the special features of the valley and the Hohe Tauern National Park. You will also learn what once made the Gastein Valley prosperous, why it has long been a central location, and how tourism and the national park complement each other here. Upon reaching the Prossau alpine inn, there is the option of a short detour towards the Tischlerkar waterfalls. The return follows the same route.
