The panorama of the Hohe Tauern by night

Level of difficulty:

Easy snowshoe tour through gentle terrain, with a relatively short walking time.

Equipment:

Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), rucksack with

warm drinks and snacks

Costs:

€ 20; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their

parents.


Refreshment stops: Various options possible

Description: Starting from the Dietsteinhof youth hostel, the snowshoe hike will follow a winter hiking trail and cross-country ski trail before branching off to a slightly higher elevation. From here you will be able to admire the full moon and the mountain panorama of the Hohe Tauern, illuminated by the bright light of the full moon. You will then continue towards Wasenmoos, a nature reserve. On the way back you will pass through a wooded area that is partially illuminated by the full moon. Definitely a highlight of your winter!
