





In the winter realm of waterfalls

Krimml's unspoilt side

Level of difficulty: Easy snowshoe tour through gentle terrain, with a relatively short walking time

Equipment: Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks,

ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen,

rucksack with warm drinks and snacks

Costs: € 20; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their

parents.

Free with the "Gästecard" or Nationalpark WinterCard!

Included in price: Snowshoe and ski stick hire (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: Every Monday (from 25.12.23–01.04.24) at 11:00 from the

Krimml tourist office

How to reach us: By bus (route 670 – "Krimml Ortsmitte" stop) or car to the

Krimml waterfall car parks.


Duration:Approx. 4-4.5 hoursPure walking time:Approx. 2-2.5 hoursRoute:Approx. 5-5.5 kilometresAscent:Approx. 300 vertical metresRefreshment stops:Possible at the end of the tour

Booking: No booking required – simply turn up at meeting point

at the specified time, our ranger will start punctually.

Description: The tour starts at the tourist office in Krimml, where participants will also receive their snowshoes from the national park ranger. After a few hundred metres, you'll strap your snowshoes on and leave the normal hiking trail – we are now on fields and meadows adorned with their winter coat. A gentle ascent will take you to places with views of Krimml and the Kitzbühel Alps. Soon you will reach the winter waterfalls. After a short rest, the tour continues along snow-covered paths and winter roads back to the starting point of the snowshoe hike.
