






Wasenmoos

Views of the Hohe Tauern

Level of difficulty: Equipment:	Easy snowshoe tour through gentle terrain, with a relatively short walking time. Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks
Costs: Included in price:	€ 20; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their parents. Free with the "Gästecard" or Nationalpark WinterCard! Snowshoe and ski stick hire (please advise when booking)
Meeting point:	Every Monday (from 25.12.23–01.04.24) at 13:00 from the Pass Thurn viewing platform
How to reach us:	By bus to the "Pass Thurn Tauernblick" bus stop or car to the viewing platform (please note: limited parking spaces!)
Duration: Pure walking time: Route: Ascent:	Approx. 3.5–4 hours Approx. 1.5–2 hours Approx. 3.5–4 kilometres Approx. 150 vertical metres
Refreshment stops:	Possible in nearby inns after the hike
Booking	No booking necessary

Description: The tour starts at the Pass Thurn viewing platform, where you can already enjoy views of the Hohe Tauern. After picking up your snowshoes, the tour to Wasenmoos begins. After a gentle ascent, views will open up deep into the national park. Crossing snow-covered meadows and fields, the snowshoe hike will repeatedly reach points with views of the mountains. The wintry moor and neighbouring forest also offer a glimpse of wildlife and their tracks away from the panoramic views. We will return to the starting point along winter paths. You will never lose sight of the Hohe Tauern mountains!
