

Nationalpark Hohe Tauern

Crossing the Habachscharte + Plattiger Habach 3207m (ski tour)

Level of difficulty:	"Alpine tours that require good physical fitness, more than 5 hrs total time and/or steeper terrain; led by a state-certified mountain guide."
Equipment:	Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet), winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks, sun and cold protection;
Costs:	€ 40 per person not including taxi costs
Participants:	min. 4 people, max. 6 people
Hire:	Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)
Meeting point:	Saturday, 13.04.2024, at the Habachtal car park; the time will be agreed with the mountain guide at the time of booking.
How to reach us:	By bus (route 670 – "Weyer Weyerhof" bus stop – followed by 20 minutes on foot) or car to the Habachtal car park.
Duration: Ascent: Descent:	Approx. 12 hrs Approx. 1700 vertical metres and 12 kilometres Approx. 2400 vertical metres and 16 kilometres

Description: A taxi takes us from the Habachtal to the starting point of the tour at the Matreier Tauernhaus. The Habachscharte is a challenging crossing of Hohe Tauern and the national park, surrounded by numerous 3000m peaks and glaciers. The specific route will be determined by snow, avalanche and weather conditions.
