

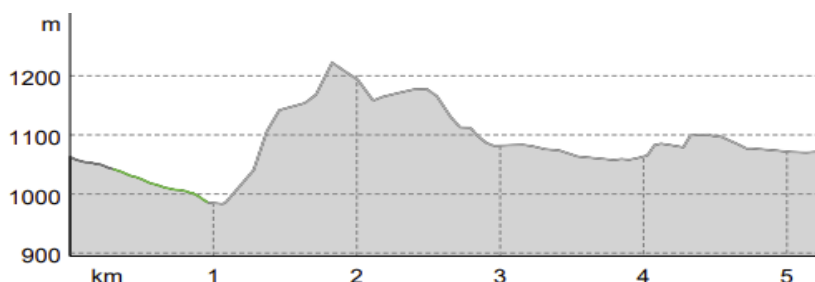
In the winter realm of waterfalls

Krimml's unspoilt side

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate snowshoe hike that requires more endurance, a longer walking time, or steeper terrain.
- Equipment:** Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen, rucksack with warm drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** € 22,- adults; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their parents. Free with the "Gästecard" or Nationalpark WinterCard!
- Included in price:** Snowshoe and ski stick hire
- Meeting point:** Every Monday (from 30.12.24–24.03.25) at 11:00 from the Krimml tourist office, coordinates (NS 47.22207 / WO 12.17545).
- How to reach us:** By bus (route 670 – "Krimml Ortsmitte" stop) or car to the Krimml waterfall car parks.
- Duration:** Approx. 4–4.5 hours
- Pure walking time:** Approx. 2–2.5 hours
- Route:** Approx. 5–5.5 kilometres
- Ascent:** Approx. 300 vertical metres
- Refreshment stops:** Possible at the end of the tour
- Booking:** No booking required – simply turn up at meeting point at the specified time, our ranger will start punctually.

Description: The tour starts at the tourist office in Krimml, where participants will also receive their snowshoes from the national park ranger. After a few hundred metres, you'll strap your snowshoes on and leave the normal hiking trail – we are now on fields and meadows adorned with their winter coat. A gentle ascent will take you to places with views of Krimml and the Kitzbühel Alps. Soon you will reach the winter waterfalls. After a short rest, the tour continues along snow-covered paths and winter roads back to the starting point of the snowshoe hike.
