




Magical Rauris winter adventure

Wild and romantic paths in a valley of extremes

Level of difficulty:	Moderately difficult snowshoe hike that requires a very good level of fitness and takes you through steep terrain.
Equipment:	Sturdy, ankle-high footwear (ideally hiking boots); warm socks, ski sticks, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen, rucksack with warm drinks and snacks
Costs:	€ 22 adults; Children and young people (10–16 yrs) free when accompanied by their parents. Free with Guest Card or National Park WinterCard!
Included in price:	Snowshoe rental is included in the price.
Meeting point: How to reach us:	Every Wednesday (from 01.01.25–26.03.25) at 10:10 from the Bodenhaus car park, coordinates (N/S 47.10510, W/O 12.99169). By the "Tälerbus" or car to the Bodenhaus car park. The tour start time is coordinated with the arrival time of the valley bus!

Description: The snowshoe tour starts at the Bodenhaus car park, which can be reached by bus or car. After putting on your snowshoes, you will leave the road and walk across snow-covered meadows and fields. On the way you will pass winter ponds and catch glimpses of the snow-covered Hüttwinkel valley. After about 2km we will leave the edge of the forest and enter the woods where, with a bit of luck, we may see animal tracks. The way back follows the Hüttwinklache stream, alternating between forest and clearings. A magical snowshoe hike is guaranteed!
