

Crossing Ammertaler Höhe (ski tour)

Level of difficulty: Challenging ski tour that requires very good physical fitness and, in some sections, a head for heights, with a total walking time of more than 5 hours and/or steeper terrain. The tour is led by a state-certified mountain guide.

Equipment: Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet), winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks, sun and cold protection;

Costs: € 40 per person

Participants: min. 2 people, max. 6 people

Hire: Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: "Saturday, March 22, 2025, at the parking lot Felbertauern Nordportal. The time will be arranged promptly with the mountain guide upon registration. Coordinates: N 47.160338, W 12.53663."

How to reach us: Follow the Felbertauernstraße (B108) to the north portal of the Felbertauern Tunnel. Right here, you will clearly see the meeting point 'Parking lot Felbertauern Tunnel North Portal.

Duration: Approx. 7 hrs

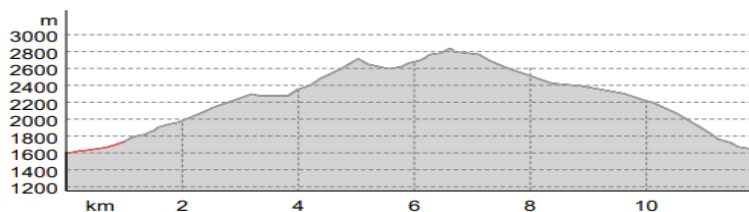
Ascent: Approx. 1350 vertical metres and 5 kilometres

Descent: Approx. 1350 vertical metres and 6 kilometres

Description: From the parking lot at the Felbertauern North Portal, at the foot of the distinctive rock face of Hochgasser, the ascent route leads inward towards Amertalersee. During the climb to the Amertalerscharte, you cross the border into the winter national park. This is followed by a short descent and another ascent over the Daberkees to Amertaler Höhe. After a leisurely summit break, the elevation gained is rewarded with a long descent over the frozen Dabersee to the south portal of the Felbertauern Tunnel.
