

Crossing the Habachscharte + Plattiger Habach 3207m (ski tour)

Level of difficulty: Challenging ski tour that requires very good physical fitness and, in some sections, a head for heights, with a total walking time of more than 5 hours and/or steeper terrain. The tour is led by a state-certified mountain guide.

Equipment: Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet), winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks, sun and cold protection;

Costs: € 40 per person not including taxi costs

Participants: min. 4 people, max. 6 people

Hire: Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: Saturday, 15.03.2024 and Saturday, 29.03.2025, at the Habachtal car park; the time will be agreed with the mountain guide at the time of booking.

How to reach us: By bus (route 670 – "Weyer Weyerhof" bus stop – followed by 20 minutes on foot) or car to the Habachtal car park.

Duration: Approx. 12 hrs

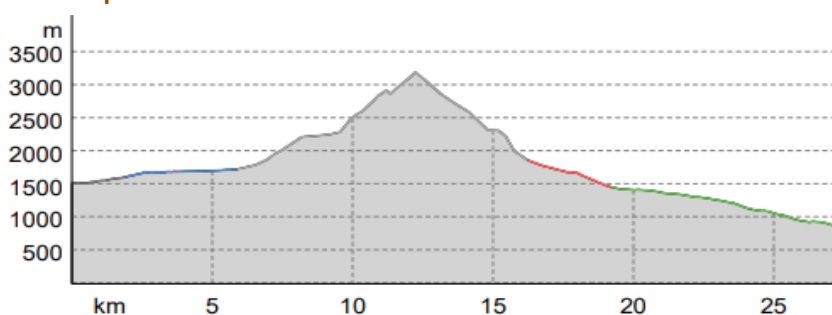
Ascent: Approx. 1700 vertical metres and 12 kilometres

Descent: Approx. 2400 vertical metres and 16 kilometres

Description: A taxi takes us from the Habachtal to the starting point of the tour at the Matreier Tauernhaus. The Habachscharte is a challenging crossing of Hohe Tauern and the national park, surrounded by numerous 3000m peaks and glaciers. The specific route will be determined by snow, avalanche and weather conditions.
