





Moderate ski tour to the Hinteres Modereck

Level of difficulty: Moderately difficult ski tour that requires very good physical fitness, with a

total walking time of more than 5 hours and/or steeper terrain.

The tour is led by a state-certified mountain guide.

Equipment: Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet),

winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks

and snacks, sun and cold protection;

Costs: € 40 per person + Toll for the Großglockner High Alpine Road

Participants: min. 2 people, max. 6 people

Hire: Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)

Meeting point: Sunday, 04.05.2025, at 05:50 at the Parkplatz Ferleiten.

How to reach us: From Bruck an der Glocknerstraße via the B107 through Fusch to Ferleiten.

The Ferleiten parking lot is located directly and clearly visible on the side of

Ascent: Approx. 990 vertical metres and 6 kilometres **Descent:** Approx. 990 vertical metres and 5,5 kilometres



Description: The highest point of the Glocknerstraße serves as an ideal starting point for a tour with beautiful spring snow descents in the Rauris section of the National Park. The tour begins with a long traverse over the Tauernkopf, Roßscharte, and Weißenbachscharte, leading to the Hinteres Modereck. After a scenic break, the length of the descent towards the north can be adjusted based on the conditions and your endurance. The elevation lost on the descent towards Seidlwinkltal must then be regained on the way back to the Weißenbachscharte. This is definitely a great tour to wind down the ski touring season.
