

## From Nassfeld to the scenic Ortberg (ski tour)

**Level of difficulty:** Moderate ski tour that requires very good fitness, with more than 5 hours of total walking time and/or leads through steeper terrain; guided by a certified mountain guide.

**Equipment:** Ski touring equipment (skis, sticks, skins, crampons, helmet), winter clothing, change of clothes, alpine rucksack with warm drinks and snacks, sun and cold protection;

**Costs:** € 40 per person

**Participants:** min. 2 people, max. 7 people

**Hire:** Avalanche equipment (please advise when booking)

**Meeting point:** On Monday, February 10, 2025, at the parking lot Nassfeld/Sportgastein. The exact start time will be announced promptly by the mountain guide. Coordinates: N 47.06112, W 13.05786

**How to reach us:** The Nassfeld parking lot can be reached by bus line 550 or by car via the toll road Sportgastein. Coordinates: N 47.06112, W 13.05786

**Duration:** Approx. 6 hrs

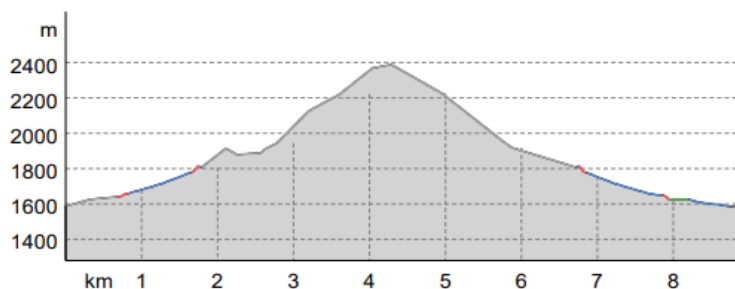
**Ascent:** Approx. 840 vertical metres and 4,5 kilometres

**Descent:** Approx. 840 vertical metres and 4,5 kilometres

**Description:** The ski tour begins with an ascent along a snow-covered forest road towards the Bockhartseehütte. Just before the hut, a short steep section must be overcome. After crossing the dam, you reach the Ortberg via a moderately steep ridge. This inconspicuous summit rewards you with a beautiful panorama of the surrounding peaks of the Golberg and Ankogel groups. The Keeskogel, Ankogel, Hochalmspitze, Hohe Sonnblick, and Hocharn are 3000-meter peaks located in the national park and can be seen from this vantage point on clear days. The descent follows the ascent route towards Nassfeld.
